ENTRY TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please note:

Any entries received after the closing date (31 January 2023 for teams, 28 February 2023 for individuals) will not be allowed.

Any entry and event package payments not received by or on 10 February 2023 for teams / 2 March 2023 for individuals will result in the entry being cancelled.

Any outstanding membership or championship invoices as of 10 February 2023 for or for individuals will result in the entry being cancelled.

Please enter teams under your country name eg. "Sweden" rather than "Team Sweden"

Please send your hotel and travel information to ps@sihlsports.ch. Entries can be made from December 2023. The hotel form must be submitted by latest 28 February 28 for teams and individuals, squad orders are submitted online by form by 2 March 2023 and the travel form by 2 March 2023.

Closing date

The closing date for Team entries is **31 January 2023**.

The closing date for Individual entries is **28 February 2023**.

Payment of entry fee and event package

All players, coaches, managers and other officials must be registered with ESF. This must be approved and validated by the relevant MNF. The MNF is responsible for ensuring that all players, coaches, managers and other officials are registered with ESF prior to entry, and their entry is fully supported.

Coaches

All team or individual player coaches designated by their nation as part of their event onsite management team (solely, or in attendance with an appointed team manager) at any Championship held under the auspices of ESF must be ESF Registered i.e. have a ESF European Squash ID as their licence to attend in a formal representative role. This is required at the time of them being registered to attend by their national federation

Withdrawals

In the event of a withdrawal from the Championships, after the closing date, penalty fees additional to the entry fee will apply in accordance with Regulations Section A.

EVENT PACKAGE

Payment of entry fee plus the event package cost per person is a mandatory payment within 10 days of the entry deadline.

CHAMPIONSHIPS HOTEL

TRANSPORT

The organisers will provide transport between designated arrival/departure points and the hotel and between hotel and venue (Regulations Section A5). The designated arrival / departure points are Zurich airport and Zurich main station (train).

TIME FRAME

Matches of the individual event are scheduled to commence on Saturday 1 April 2023 at 09.00. The Team Managers' and Coaches' meeting will take place at the venue at 20.00 on Friday 31 March 2023. The Prize-giving Ceremony will take place 20.00 on Tuesday 4 April 2023. All teams are expected to be present.

Matches of the team event are scheduled to commence on Thursday 6 April 2022 at 10.00. The Team Managers' and Coaches' meeting will take place at the venue at 20.00 on Wednesday 5 April 2023. The Prize-giving Ceremony will take place 19.00 on Sunday 9 April 2023. All teams are expected to be present.

PLAYING ORDER IN THE TEAM EVENT

The playing order of matches in all Ties on each day of the Championships will be drawn at the Managers' Meeting on 5 April 2023 at 20.00 and shall be posted in the hotel and venue and also on the tournament website after the Manager's Meeting.

ELIGIBILITY

Player eligibility for the Championships is shown in Regulations - Section B2.

SEEDING AND DRAWS

The seeding and draw will be carried out by the Seeding Panel under the direction of the ESF Event Director and in accordance with Section W5 of the Championships Regulations.

Member nations have no right of appeal against final seeding or draws.

PRACTICE COURTS

Practice facilities will be provided at no cost by the organiser and will be available at the venue starting the day before the Championships (Regulations – Section F6).

REFEREES

There will be qualified referees at the tournament. Most matches will be refereed by them, but players can still be expected to referee some matches.

SCORING

PAR 11 scoring will be used (to 2 clear points).

SQUASH BALLS

The Dunlop PRO XX ball will be used.

CHAMPIONSHIPS OFFICE

The Championships Office will be located at the venue and will be open from 08.00 until 22.00 on all playing days. The day before both individual and team events it will be open from 14.00 until 20.00.

DOPE TESTING

The ESF and the hosts reserve the right to implement compulsory dope testing for any player participating in the Championships. Dope testing may be carried out in line with the doping regulations published by the WSF. Member nations are responsible for informing all their participants (including managers, coaches and physiotherapists) about the latest WSF policy on doping; and must impose the standard WSF suspension from all forms of competitive squash upon a player who has used banned substances or practices.

INSURANCE AND RISKS

MNA's enter the event at their own risk, in case of force majeure the hosting MNA nor the ESF can be held responsible for all the caused damage.

Players enter and play in the Championships at their own risk. Neither the ESF, the Host Association, the Host Club nor the Organisers will accept any responsibility for injury or other damages arising from participation in the Championships. ESF recommends that all officials and participants have full travel, medical and possessions insurance when travelling to any Championships.

CLOTHING AND ADVERTISING

The ESF clothing and advertising regulations will be adhered to. In all matters of judgement or opinion arising from the interpretation of this clothing regulation, the decision of the Championships Referee shall be final.

EYE PROTECTION

All junior players (under 19 years of age) must wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play. The list of WSF Certified Eyewear allowable at the time of participation can be viewed on the WSF website.



VISA PROCEDURES

Please note that visas may be required to enter the country. It is the responsibility of the member nation to ensure all players and officials have the appropriate documentation and that visas are applied for in good time before the Championships.

ALCOHOL & SMOKING

There will be no alcohol available to players during the tournament and smoking on the premises of venue and hotel is forbidden.
